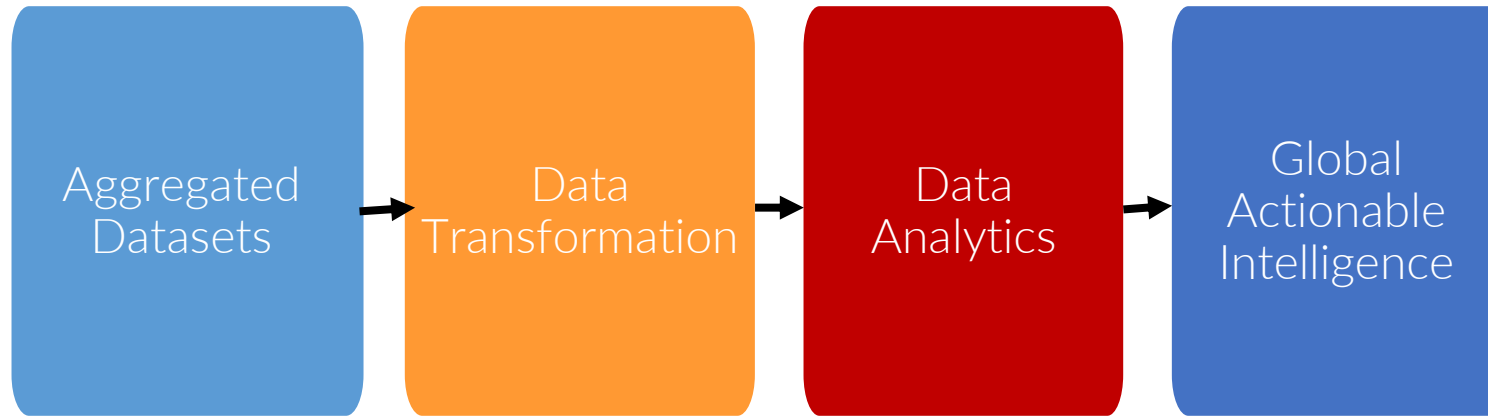

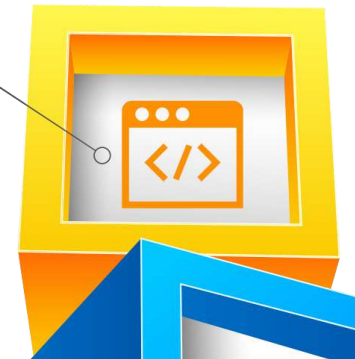
Operating Model for Threat Response

Dangers of the internet - Myths



- 1. Online child sex offenders are always older males**
- 2. Online child sex offenders are always online strangers**
- 3. High school-aged children are more at risk of online child sexual exploitation**
- 4. Only females are at risk of online child sexual exploitation**

Dangers of the internet - Myths



- 5. Parental controls and privacy settings are enough to keep children and young people safe online**
- 6. Children's games (on gaming consoles or apps) are always safer**
- 7. Children and young people in smaller or more isolated towns are safer from online child sex offenders**
- 8. Online grooming is a long process so there would be time for parents or carers to notice the signs**

Its tough being a parent



- **Talk to your children – never blame them**
- **Understand their online activities**
- **Monitor their online usage**
- **Children need your permission to meet anyone they have met online**
- **Control the access to devices**
- **Educate them about the risk of providing too much information on social media sites**
- **Educate them to say no and be wary of online threats**
